Where? 3052 SE 54th Ave., Owatonna, MN. (Travel south 8/10^{ths} of a mile on SE 54th Ave. from it’s junction with Hwy. 14 at the RR tracks just east of Havana – facility is on the right (west) side of SE 54th Ave. Look for the signs.)

When? Join us every Monday from 7:00 to 9:00PM, starting April 6, 2009.
